

This is a new scheme run in conjunction with The Reigate Grammar School Foundation to help students with their university and career choices while they are at school and beyond.

How will I benefit?

There are three stages to the scheme; each brings different benefits to those taking part:

At school

 In the 7th form we will give you extra help to make your university choice by putting you in contact with an Old Reigatian currently at university. Find out the facts behind the glossy brochures and slick websites!

At university

 When you are in your final year at university we will try to put you in touch with an Old Reigatian in your chosen career. The help that these contacts will give you may range from advice via email or telephone about your choices after university, to providing opportunities for work experience.

At work

 For Old Reigatians who are at work we will continue to expand your networking opportunities. Some of the existing methods include the Reigate Grammar School Business Directory, the RGS Review, ORA Register, ORA annual news booklet and reunions.

How will it work?

• The Foundation and Alumni office will contact all RGS students during the Autumn term of the 7th form. We will explain the programme and how to obtain details of *Network OR* contacts at university.

- In return for receiving this help, we will ask 7th form leavers to stay in *Network OR* when they move on to university.
- The Foundation and Alumni Office will keep in contact with you while you are at university and will ask you to give advice to the 7th formers choosing university.
- During your last year at university we will contact you again to offer to put you in contact with Old Reigatians in business or industry.
- If you use *Network OR*, we will ask you to provide us with feedback by filling in a short form. Your views and experiences will help us maintain a high quality programme.
