

LOGO 1 teaching schedule

Below is the suggested topic coverage over the one year German beginner's course using the textbook **LOGO 1**. Further resources include: **LOGO Elektro 1**, www.klar.co.uk; www.languagesonline.org.uk. **LOGO 1 Übungsheft** provides additional reading, grammar and writing tasks.

Aim to cover one teaching point per day.**

Month	Topic	Themes/teaching points
September – October Half-Term	Kapitel 1: Guten Tag! pp. 6-21	Greetings; giving and asking for name, age and birthday; numbers 0-31; ordinal numbers; countries; German alphabet; days, months, seasons; colours; classroom & pencil case items; classroom language; compass points
November – Christmas	Kapitel 2: Die Schule pp. 22-37	School subjects & opinions about them; timetable; asking & giving the time; clothes & school uniform; snacks & drinks at break time; numbers 32-60; classroom language; EXTRA themes: nationalities; weather; St. Nikolaus & Christmas
January – February Half-Term	Kapitel 3: Meine Familie pp. 38-53	Family members; physical descriptions; personal characteristics; pets; letter writing

End of Feb. - Easter	Kapitel 4: Freizeit pp. 54-69	Sports and hobbies; likes & dislikes of hobbies; talking about your favourite things and weekend activities
End of April – May Half-Term	Kapitel 5: Zu Hause pp. 70-85	Area where you live, i.e. countryside, village, town etc.; addresses & phone numbers; rooms in the house, floors, furniture; prepositions
Last week BEFORE Half-Term	Oral and Listening tests (part of the end-of-year exam) – Kapitel 1-5	All themes as in chapters 1-5
First week after May Half-Term	End-of-year exam based on Kapitel 1-5	All themes as in chapters 1-5
June - July	Kapitel 6: In der Stadt 86-100	Town descriptions; town facilities; numbers up to 100; ordering food & drink in an ice-cream café; snack foods; ways of practising German
