

LOGO 2 teaching schedule

Below is the suggested topic coverage for the one year German intermediate course using the textbook **LOGO 2**. Further resources include: **LOGO Elektro 2**, www.klar.co.uk; www.languagesonline.org.uk. **LOGO 2 Übungsheft** provides additional reading, grammar and writing tasks.

***Remote learning: In case of the school being closed due to a flu-pandemic or similar or in case of longer individual pupil absence, please follow the schedule below using your LOGO 2 textbook and white workbook (i.e. the Übungsheft) and www.klar.co.uk. The login for this website is: RGS1. The password is: Lebkuchen. The topics are clearly labelled in different folders on this website. The back of the textbook provides detailed grammar explanations, exercises and a word list (pp. 122-142). Start from the last topic/teaching point of the last lesson you attended. Aim to cover one teaching point per day.**

A more detailed scheme of work for teachers can be downloaded and printed off from German Shared on the U-drive.

This schedule can be subject to amendment if necessary.

NB: An end-of-unit test will assess the pupils' progress after every two chapters.

Month	Topic	Themes/teaching points
September – October Half-Term	Kapitel 1: Die Kölner Clique pp. 6-23	Asking for & giving personal details; weather & seasons; questions in class; revision of the time; activities that happened in the past & at certain times in the past
November – Christmas	Kapitel 2: Unterwegs pp. 24-41	Description of a recent holiday; means of transport; holiday accommodation; activities on a recent trip; buying train tickets; lost property; writing a holiday postcard
January – February Half-Term	Kapitel 3: Topfit! pp.42-59	Body parts; illnesses & injuries; at the doctor's; keeping fit; daily routine
End of Feb. - Easter	Kapitel 4: Essen und einkaufen pp.60-77	Breakfast food; fruit & vegetables; at the market; types & locations of shops; pocket money

End of April – May Half-Term	Kapitel 5: Los geht's nach Köln pp.78-95	Talking about your family; staying with a German host family; talking about a journey; making suggestions & plans for going out; future outings; directions
Last week BEFORE Half-Term	Oral and Listening tests (part of the end-of-year exam) – Kapitel 1-5	All themes as in chapters 1-5
First week after May Half-Term	End-of-year exam based on Kapitel 1-5	All themes as in chapters 1-5
June - July	Kapitel 6: Unter Freunden pp. 96-109	Invitations to go out; reasons/excuses for not going out; clothes you like to wear; your last birthday; TV programmes you like/dislike; talking about activities you <i>want</i> to do
